# **ROLL NO. 1 TO 40**

#### **ART: Thumb Painting Composition**

*Objective:* To create a unique and creative composition using thumb painting.

*Materials:* Paper (preferably thick or watercolor), Paint (various colors), Paint tray or palette, Water, Paper towels.

Instructions:

- 1. Preparation: Wash and dry hands thoroughly.
- 2. Design: Sketch a simple design or outline on paper.
- 3. Thumb Painting: Dip thumb in paint and apply to paper, creating patterns, shapes, or designs.
- 4. Color Exploration: Experiment with different colors and techniques (e.g., layering, blending).
- 5. Composition: Balance and arrange elements within the composition.
- 6. Thumb Only: Use only thumbs for painting.
- 1. Brushes\*: can use brushes or other tools to give the final touch .
- 7. Cleanliness: Keep hands and workspace clean.
- 8. Experimentation: Encourage creativity and experimentation.

#### Tips:

- Practice: Experiment with thumb painting techniques before creating a final piece.
- Color Mixing: Mix colors to create unique shades and hues.
- Pattern Play: Explore different patterns and textures.



#### Craft: Decorative Glass Bottle Craft Using Yarn, Jute, and Cotton Dori

*Materials Needed:* Empty glass bottle (cleaned & label removed), Jute rope or Coloured yarn or cotton dori Craft glue (Fevicol) Scissors. *Optional decorations: buttons, beads, shells, dried flowers* 

#### Step-by-Step Instructions :

1. Prepare the Bottle: Ensure the glass bottle is clean and dry. Remove any labels using warm water or rubbing thinner.

2. Wrap the Base with Jute: Apply glue at the bottom of the bottle. Start wrapping the jute rope tightly around the base, gluing every few inches.

3. Add Color with Yarn/Dori: Switch to colored yarn or cotton dori for a decorative layer. Wrap neatly and glue in place. Alternate between jute and yarn to make patterns

4. Decorate Your Bottle: Add buttons, beads, shells, or bows to the yarn for extra style.(optional). Wrap the bottle neck with jute or braid yarn/dori for a finished look.

5. Finishing Touches: Let all glue dry completely. Add dried flowers, paper flowers, or fairy lights inside the bottle if desired.

You can choose the color combinations.

**VOCAL MUSIC:** *Instructions:* Students are required to write the National Anthem ("Jana Gana Mana") and the National Song ("Vande Mataram") neatly on an A3 size sheet.(Any colour).

- A beautiful decorative border must be drawn around the chart paper.
- The work should be done neatly and creatively.


- Learn and revise numbers beyond 9999.


