ACTIVITY TIME

ART: Squiggling Art Activity

Materials Needed: White drawing paper, Black pen or marker, Colored pencils, crayons, or markers

Instructions:

- 1. Make a composition of your own choice it can be anything like landscape ,flowers, animals etc
- 2. Colour the base using any light colour then make a Squiggle:
- 3. Take a black pen or marker coloured sketch pen and draw a random, wiggly, curvy squiggle on the paper. It can loop, swirl, or zigzag—there's no right or wrong!

Observe the Squiggle: Look at your squiggle from different angles. Turn It into Art: Use the squiggle as the base of your drawing. Add details around or inside it to create a picture. For example, turn a loop into a snail's shell or a swirl into a tornado. Add colors to bring your squiggling art to life. Use any medium like: , colored pencils, watercolors, for base colour etc.



CRAFT: Popsicle Stick Wall Art

Materials Needed: Popsicle sticks (colored or plain) 100, Glue (white glue or craft glue), cardboard (for background support), Scissors (with supervision), Crayons, markers, or paints (if using plain sticks), String or ribbon (for hanging)

Instructions:

1. Plan the Design: Decide on a simple shape or pattern—like a square, triangle, heart, or zig-zaget .Sketch the design lightly on a piece of paper or cardboard for guidance.

2. Build the Base: Arrange the popsicle sticks in your chosen shape. For example, lay them side by side in a row to form a square or rectangle.

3. Glue the Sticks Together: Apply glue where the sticks touch and press them firmly. Let it dry for a

few minutes so it holds well.

- 4. Decorate: Use brush pen or markers to color the sticks if they are plain. Add glitter, beads, or drawings to make it beautiful and unique.
- 5. Attach the Backing: Glue your design onto cardboard if it needs support. Trim the excess paper around the shape for a clean finish.
- 6. Add a Hanger: Glue a loop of string or ribbon to the back so it can be hung on the wall.
- 7. Let It Dry: Leave your artwork to dry completely before displaying. Let students choose their own colors and designs. Encourage patterns like rainbow colors, zig-zags, or letter shapes (like their initials)



DANCE: Create a poster on an A3 size sheet, showcasing different Indian folk dances. Including images and description of each dance form

MUSIC: Write 10-15 lines about your favourite singer/ musician and paste the picture on an A3 size sheet and decorate the border.

Or

Write the definition of music, swara, taal and laya on an A3 size sheet and decorate the border.


Now answer the following points:

- Give your pizza a name and price it creatively using rupees and paise. One is shown as an example:







- Bandhani (Rajasthan/Gujarat)
- Kantha (West Bengal)
- Zardozi (Lucknow),etc.
- Cut and paste them in an artistic design (flower, peacock, scenery, map, tree, etc.) on a A3 sheet.
- Label the states and art forms neatly.
- Keep your composition colorful and unique.
