



- 4. Draw and explain the diagram (with the help of beads/pulses, threads, leaves etc) of life cycle of silkworm on A-3 size sheet. Click the picture of diagram drawn on sheet and use it in the making of ppt.
- 5. Write about the history of spinning jenny and use the following inputs:
 - a) Father of invention
 - b) Pictures related to it.
 - c) Changes brought in the textile industry due to the invention of spinning jenny
- 6. Digestive system in humans. Explain different parts of alimentary canal and state their function in digestion (refer to chapter 2 of your book)
- 7. Respiratory system in humans. Also explain the process of inhalation and exhalation, difference between aerobic and anaerobic respiration.
