


Q2) In this matchstick puzzle, you are required to take away 8 matchsticks so as to leave just two squares.




Q3) This pattern is made up of 12 matchsticks to make 5 squares (4 small and 1 big). You are required to move only 2 matchsticks to make 7 squares.





GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCIENCE:

- Prepare a **Power point presentation OR a project report** (maximum 5-6 slides/pages including back and front) on ANY ONE of the following topics.
- Class 10 A and B will make on any one topic of Physics from the listed Physics Topics; Class 10 C and D will make on any one topic of Chemistry from the listed Chemistry Topics and Class 10 E and F will make on any one topic of Biology from the listed Biology Topics.
- Making power point presentation of hand drawn diagrams is also allowed.
- The work submitted by the student should be in PDF format in one single file. The scanned copy or pictures of the project report should also be converted to single PDF file before sending it.
- Students have to include the following information in their power point presentation or project report: Name of student, class and section, subject and topic chosen.

PHYSICS TOPICS (10 A AND 10 B)

- 1. State Ohm's Law. Draw V-I graph obtained on the basis of Ohm's Law. Give its Mathematical Formulation. Describe Voltmeter and Ammeter used to experimentally derive Ohm's Law. Write the importance and way to find Least Count and Range of the two devices.
- 2. Write about the topic "Safe Use of Electricity in Domestic Circuits". Describe about any two "safety devices" which are used in domestic circuits.
- 3. Elaborate on the various non-conventional sources of energy in modern world. Illustrate with the help of graphs and data about fall in energy demand during coronavirus Pandemic

Chemistry topics; (10C and 10 D)

- Q1 Write 20 chemical equations (You can find these chemical equations from various sources like text book /reference book /internet etc.
 - (i) Write names of each reactant and product underneath the equation.
 - (ii) Balance each of the chemical equations.
 - (iii) identify the type of reaction in each case.
- Q2 Prepare a project report on Corrosion and rancidity.
 - Corrosion- definition, reactions involved in the corrosion of iron, silver and copper and four preventive measures.
 - Rancidity- definition, three basic types of rancidity and four preventive measures.
- Q3 Write the name of any five chemical compounds that you use in your day to day life;
 - (i) classify them as acids ,bases or salts.
 - (ii) Write colour change that takes place with one natural and one man made acid -base indicator.
 - (iii) Preparation of each chemical compound and its two uses.

BIOLOGY TOPICS (10E and 10 F)

- Q.1 To show experimentally that carbon dioxide is given out during respiration.
- Q.2 To prepare a temporary Mount of leaf to show stomata.
- Q.3 To study binary fission in Amoeba and budding in yeast with the help of permanent slides.
- Q.4 To identify the different parts of an embryo of a dicot seed- pea, gram and red Bean.

1. (GUIDELINES FOR THE TOPICS)

Consumer Awareness -Your project should reflect the following points or any other aspect can also be Included.

This project proposes to discuss the issue of consumer rights within the context of the ways markets operate in our country.

There are many aspects of unequal situations in a market and poor enforcement of rules and regulations.

Discuss how some consumers are exploited in a real-life situation and how legal institutions help consumers in getting compensated and in upholding their rights.

Express how the awareness of being a well-informed consumer and active participation of people is important. Mention a few organisations helping consumers in different ways.

Social Issues-

Social issues have plagued the life of too many people. Many times you may have noticed that a lot of things in the society which doesn't seem good. For instance, you must have noticed poor children begging on the streets. They don't go to school. They have been forced to beg for a living. Such circumstances along with others which affect the population at large are social issues. Begging is an issue which arises out of poverty. Poverty is itself is one of the major social issues in India. It is important to understand the general social issues of our society and how they impact the lives of the people of the country. Take any two social issues that we face today and explain them in detail . Keep the following points in mind. Your project should reflect the following points or any other aspect can also be included.

What is a Social Issues-

A social issue is a problem that influences a considerable number of individuals. It is an aspect of society that people are concerned about and would like to get it changed. The concern of a social issue may be objective or subjective. A social issue arises due to diverse opinions of individuals based on what is perceived as right. Social issue does not necessarily refer to an ill to be solved, but it may be a topic to be discussed. Social issues can be different groups, societies, countries and world.

Causes of the Social Issues:

There are many causes of the social issues. Social issues arise due to inequalities in society. Different individuals and different societies may have different perceptions about a problem giving rise to a social issue. There can be disagreements about which social issue is important and worth solving, or which should take precedence.

Solving Social Issues:

There are a variety of methods to resolve variety of social issues. These include political processes, non-profit organizations, community groups and volunteering to have public dialogue on a social issue and arrive at a most acceptable solution.

Sustainable Development-

What is sustainable development? "Development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs"

Your project should reflect the following points or any other aspect can also be included

- Is sustainable development just about saving the environment, or other are there other factors involved such as human welfare, construction, politics or economics?
- What are different types of activities or projects that fall under sustainable development?
- What are some national sustainable development projects?
- Are there any local sustainable development projects?
- What are some international sustainable development projects?
- What are the benefits of sustainable development?
- What are problems and challenges associated with sustainable development?
- What are some organizations that are involved in sustainable development?

3. General instructions for Social Science

- The Project should be in a PPT FORM WITH MAXIMUM 20 SLIDES OR HANDWRITTEN.
- While Making a PROJECT the first page you must write the following
 - a) Name
- b) Class and section
- c) Topic
- Holiday homework needs to be submitted to the respective subject teachers on the day school reopens after summer break. YOU HAVE TO SEND IT IN A GOOGLE FOLDER THAT YOU HAVE CREATED FOR THE SUBJECT.
- Use of the pictures, cartoons, magazines and newspapers clippings etc. where possible. Be creative. Do not just copy paste reading material from internet.
